THU / NOV 09 **ROME / NAPLES**

This morning you leave Rome when you are transferred to the railway station where you board a first class train to Naples. Upon arrival to Naples you will be met and transferred to the Excelsior Hotel where you check in to your room.

Take time to enjoy lunch on your own before being picked up and transferred to the ancient site of Pompeii. In Pompeii you will be joined by a local guide and embark on a walking tour of southern Italy's most famous site.

The onetime affluent Pompeii was buried in 79 AD by one of the most disastrous volcanic eruptions in history. Wander through the temples, theatres, shops and streets (note the ancient advertising and graffiti on the walls!), even venturing into the houses – many of them remarkably intact including pots and pans in the kitchen and artwork (some of it quite erotic!) on the walls.

Transferred back to Naples and the Excelsior.

Enjoy your stay in Naples at the Hotel Excelsior which overlooks the seaside promenade of elegant Naples and is close to the city's most famous shops and attractions. A splendid "Palazzo", built in 1908, the Excelsior unites tradition and innovation with modern luxury and a touch of antiquity. Furnished in the style and ambiance of the Belle époque, the hotel features exquisite cuisine and breathtaking views of the harbor, gulf and the volcano Mt. Vesuvius. It also includes a fitness center. Guestrooms are individually appointed with antique furniture air-conditioning, satellite TV and mini-bar.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

RESERVATIONS: Bookings will be made and confirmations received after receipt of a PER PERSON deposit in the amount of \$100.00 (independent tours). Certain custom programs may require additional deposits as suppliers warrant. Deposits are due within 7 days of booking. Late fees of \$75.00 or more per booking address apply for bookings made within 15 business days of departure. Full payment for independent or custom/special interest tours due for bookings made within 45 days prior to departure unless otherwise specified. Full payment for DJI Express due 30 days prior to departure. Travel Insurance is recommended and can be purchased for an additional cost, through DJI.

FINAL PAYMENT: Deposits are Non-refundable. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. For reservations and payments made 15 business days (as conditions apply) or less prior to departure, subject to a late booking fee of \$75.00 per booking address. Quoted price represents a “package price” for services offered and an itemization of individual component costs will not be made under any circumstances. Hotels and other components of tour package are subject to availability at the time of booking.

Note: In compliance with Illinois state law and the Travel Promotion Consumer Protection Act, DJI Ltd. shall deposit 90% of all tour deposits and final payments into a special trust account in Harris Bank. DJI Ltd. shall withdraw money from this account under the following circumstances: (1) for partial or full payment for the services contracted for/by the traveler(s) to the person providing the services offered by DJI Ltd., (2) to make refunds provided for by written contract between DJI Ltd. and traveler(s) as outlined in the cancellation policy below or (3) to transfer balance to DJI Ltd. after tour has commenced.

CHANGES: Once a tour is confirmed, a charge of \$25.00 per booking, per change, will apply.

HOTELS: Special room requests can be taken in advance but are not guaranteed. Additional costs apply for upgraded rooms. Hotel rooms are generally not available until 12:00 Noon. Check-out time is generally 11:00 AM. Single accommodations based on single rooms, which can be considered small by North American standards. Air-conditioning in European hotels is not always up to the standards of the USA. DJI reserves the right to substitute hotels listed for accommodations of similar standard as conditions may require. Portage and city taxes are not included in the price, unless otherwise indicated.

RENTAL CARS: Include unlimited mileage, Collision Damage Waiver, theft protection and taxes. Additional driver cost, drop or delivery charges, one-way fees, bonds, etc etc. are payable directly to rental car company and not included in DJI tour packages. Parking fees, tolls and other incidental services are the responsibility of the traveler(s), and not included in tour cost. Note, in some cities, towns and villages some hotels, shops and sites may not be accessible by vehicle. In such cases, vehicles are left outside, below, or above city walls and/or villages and/or towns.

Note: Should you return your rental car later than expected, you may be charged for additional day(s) which must be paid directly to rental car company. All rental cars must be returned with a full tank of gas to avoid additional charges.

TRAIN TRAVEL: If first-class rail tickets or passes are included, DJI will make necessary seat reservations per itinerary in travelers’ best interest. One passes or/and tickets are issued there are no refunds for missed trains, changes, cancellations or unused portions.

TOURS: For programs including private city tours by English-speaking professional guide(s), additional charges may apply for entrance fees. For programs including private city tours by English-speaking driver, please note that the driver cannot give interior visits and no entrance fees are included. Note: most often drivers are not professional licenses guides and cannot be expected to have detailed knowledge when visiting some sites. Any excess mileage requested by tour members will be at travelers’ own expense and must be paid directly to local operator. Other sightseeing, as indicated in the itinerary, is only suggested by DJI based on self-drive rental car or independent touring so entrance fees are not included.

Special Note: Please communicate locally with your guide or driver. Asking questions or simply talking about the sites will “open up” your guide or driver, bringing the trip to a personal level and ultimately enhancing the overall tour experience. Copies of your personal itinerary have been forwarded to our overseas offices in order to brief your guide or driver. However,

should you wish to make an additional stop to shop, have a snack, etc., you will need to relay this to your guide or drive/guide locally. Deviations to your itinerary are possible, provided there is a limited increase in mileage and time.

TRANSFERS: If included in tour program, transfers are based on a private car with driver. Excess baggage may create logistical problems and will incur an additional expense.

MEALS / BEVERAGES: Breakfast is included daily at hotels, except on day of arrival. Other meal, as indicated in certain programs, based on “table d’hote” meals: B=breakfast, L=lunch, D=dinner. DJI will endeavor to meet special meal request where possible, but such requests must be made prior to departure. Beverages are considered a personal expense.

BAGGAGE: Baggage and personal effects are at the owner’s risk throughout the tour. Porterage within hotels is not included for independent tours. Baggage insurance is strongly recommended and available through DJI Ltd.

TAXES / SERVICE CHARGES: Taxes, VAT, and/or service charges as assessed by hotels, local authorities, and restaurants are included for services specified in the itinerary. Local city taxes are not included, where applicable, and must be paid directly to hotels.

DOCUMENTS: Final tour documents will be sent prior to departure provided full payment has been received.

PASSPORTS: All U.S. citizens traveling to internationally require a valid passport. Passports must be valid at least six months.

NOT INCLUDED IN TOUR COST: International airfare (if choosing the “land only” tour packages); meals other than those stated in the itinerary; tips to drivers, driver/guides, and professional guides; costs of obtaining a passport; excess baggage charges; items of a purely personal nature such as beverages, telephone calls, laundry, and faxes; hotel porterage; airport departure taxes; local city taxes; airport surcharges; additional driver costs, etc. on rental cars; and excess mileage carried out at the unanimous request of the tour participants. Anything not specifically mentioned as being included is at travelers’ own expense.

CANCELLATIONS: Per Person Deposits \$100.00 (Independent Tours) are non-refundable. Custom/Special Interest tours subject to conditions stated at time of booking. File fees and deposits are non-refundable. Thereafter, the following penalties will apply: 45-31 days prior (20% of package price); 30-22 days prior (30% of package price); 21-15 days prior (65% of package price); 14 days or less prior subject to 100% of package per person.

Cancellations must be made in writing to DJI and received during normal office hours: Monday through Friday, 9:00 AM—5:00 PM Central Standard Time. DJI Ltd. reserves the right to amend these terms for independent tours or groups where suppliers dictate otherwise.

REFUNDS / CLAIMS: Once the tour has commenced, no refunds will be made for any unused portion of the tour whether for missed days, accommodations, meals, or any other service not utilized by tour participant. No refunds will be made in the event of traveler’s “no show” or trip interruption. Tour termination for whatever reason does not automatically or necessarily guarantee any refund. Trip insurance is strongly recommended and available through DJI. Claims must be made in writing and will not be accepted after 30 days of tour completion.

Payment of the tour and other services constitutes your acceptance of the Terms & Conditions outlined here-in. DJI, Ltd. purchases services and products from outside agents. Vendors, suppliers, hoteliers, rental companies, rail companies, tour companies and other outside agents cannot assure refunds of money paid to DJI, Ltd. Assurances of refunds made by outside agents are not the responsibility of DJI, Ltd.

SPECIAL NOTE: All rates are quoted in U.S. dollars based on “three-month average” rate of exchange as of January 2004 and are subject to change without notice. Rate of exchange appears on individual proposal and confirmed itineraries. Deposits do not guarantee rates of exchange and supplements can apply should there be a marked increase in rates of exchange. To guarantee average rate of exchange travelers have the option to pay in full within ten days after receipt of confirmed itinerary. Additional expenses incurred due to change or cancellation of flights will be the responsibility of the traveler.
