

# About the Hotel Grande Bretagne

After starting its life as an impressive 90-room mansion in 1830, hotelier Savvas Kentros transformed it into the Hotel Grande Bretagne in 1874. Since that time the Hotel Grand Bretagne has been a focal point of the social, political and economic life of Athens.

When Greece fell to Nazi occupation in 1941, the hotel became the headquarters of the Third Reich, with Hitler and Rommel residing in the hotel on the eve of the Soviet Invasion. With peace finally restored in 1956, the hotel was re-opened. Since that time, an endless list of royalty, heads of state, and celebrities have stayed at the hotel.

In 2003, the hotel underwent a massive \$100-million restoration and emerged as a state-of-the-art, five-star reincarnation of its former glory. The 321 rooms, including 59 suites, now marry charming old-world elegance with state-of-the-art facilities.

Located in the very center of Athens, dominating Constitution Square, the hotel is located for easy access to all major sights in Athens and within walking distance of the city's favorite shopping areas. The hotel features a state-of-the-art spa with two pools, 24-hour in-room dining, a fitness center, and a rich selection of fine dining and dining venues, including the new GB Roof Garden with breathtaking views of the Acropolis. The luxury five-star hotel is the perfect location from which to enjoy all that is Athens.



## Hotel Reservations and Room Categories

In order to make a hotel reservation at the CSAA group rate, you must submit a hotel reservation form, along with a meeting registration form, directly to CSAA. Once CSAA receives both forms, it will forward your hotel reservation form to the Hotel Grande Bretagne. Room categories are subject to availability and are on a first-come, first-served basis. Requests for cancellations or changes should be made directly with the hotel. Deadline for hotel reservations is **September 17, 2009**.

Limited availability for upgrades to the Butler floors (6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> floors) are available in all room categories. Please be aware that there is no private butler floor lounge. By upgrading to the Butler floors, you are in essence upgrading to the highest level of service.

**Butler Floors** – All guests staying on the hotel's designated Butler Floors (6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> floor), as well as guests of any of the hotel's suites enjoy many exceptional privileges in addition to standard 24-hour Butler service. Upon arrival, Butler Floor guests may proceed directly to the 6<sup>th</sup> floor for an expedited private check-in. The hotel's Assistant Front Office Manager and his team will be there to greet you personally, assist with any immediate needs you may have, and serve you a welcome refreshment. Available seven days a week from 7am to 11 pm, the private concierge services associated with the Butler Floors offer an unrivalled level of knowledge pertaining to all aspects of life in Athens.

### Rooms and Suites



Please note that the hotel is built in the form of a hollow square. A very limited number of rooms have Acropolis views. In general, rooms have atrium or city views. Views cannot be guaranteed unless you have selected the Deluxe Room with Acropolis View.
