### **CSAA Mourns the Loss of John W. Mabry Jr.**

It was with deep sadness that CSAA announced the sudden and tragic loss of CSAA Past President John W. Mabry Jr. John, a beloved security industry icon, was killed in a head-on car collision in Georgia on Friday, Nov. 18.

"I first met John 20 years ago. He was a distinguished past-president of CSAA and a member of the Board of Directors," said Steve Doyle, CSAA executive vice president and CEO.

He adds: "Over the years, the association often sought out John's advice, as he was one of the visionaries in our industry. He was immensely helpful to the staff and to the board. John's warmth and humor often spread calm on troubled waters. His insight into people and companies was always amazing. John was one of the 'movers and shakers' in our industry. He was a former Navy veteran and a true patriot, and will be sorely missed."

Mabry, who was president of CSAA from 1981 to 1983, founded and built the American Alarm Co., which was later purchased by Honeywell Inc.
