Rep. Jerrold Nadler to Speak to Attendees of CSAA 1999 Mid-Year Meeting

Attendees to CSAA's 1999 Mid-Year Meeting will be honored with the presence of **not just one, but two** of the House of Representatives' most prestigious Congressmen. Representative Bill McCollum's (R—Florida) will speak on April 27 at 8:30am (see *Signals*, April 25, 1999). Following his speech, Representative Jerrold Nadler (D—New York) will have an opportunity to address attendees. By hosting a Republican and a Democrat, CSAA shows its non-partisanship. How's that for equal time!

Currently serving his third full term in the House of Representatives, Rep. Nadler represents New York's Eighth Congressional District, which includes parts of Manhattan and Brooklyn.

He serves as the Ranking Member on the Judiciary Committee's Subcommittee on Commercial and Administrative Law, which is responsible for such key issues as consumer protection and bankruptcy law. He also serves on the Constitution Subcommittee, which is primarily responsible for reviewing all proposed constitutional amendments, and on the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

Prior to serving in Congress, Rep. Nadler served in the New York State Assembly, where he was the author of most of that State's body of law on domestic violence and child support enforcement.
