Honeywell/United Technologies Stop Acquisition Talks

Honeywell International Inc. announced that it has ended acquisition talks with **United Technologies Corp.** and that it is considering other buyout offers. Spokesmen for the two companies declined further comment.

According to reports by the **Wall Street Journal (WSJ)**, **The New York Times**, and **CNBC**, **General Electric (GE)** has made a formal bid for Honeywell. Analysts have identified **Tyco Intl. Ltd.** and Germany's **Siemens AG** as other possible suitors. □
